

Thomas Boerman, Ph. D. has been involved with the issue of Central American human rights since 1984 and is a recognized expert on the historical, cultural, social and political context of Central America. He has worked as a consultant to numerous governmental and non-governmental organizations involved in violence reduction efforts in El Salvador, Honduras, Guatemala and Panama including the U.N. High Commissioner for Refugees, the U.S. Agency for International Development, The World Bank, Save the Children—United Kingdom, and many private U.S.-based development organizations. He has presented at over 150 conferences and professional development seminars.

Since 2006, he has consulted in over 2,000 asylum matters involving Asylum seekers from El Salvador, Honduras, Guatemala and Mexico and is a member of the Executive Committee of the Expert Witness section of the Latin American Studies Association.
